- Market runs May 6th through October 28th
- Set up as early as 4:30am
- Most folks arrive 5:45am6:30am.
- Start sales when ready
- Rain or Shine



- Pull to the side when possible, unload, and drive your vehicle out. Then set up your tent and displays.
- Please drive cautiously through the market during set-up.



- ALL cars without paid spaces in Market should exit by 6:45am.
- If you arrive after 6:45am DO NOT drive your vehicle into the Market.
- If you arrive late you may walk your materials in.



- NO VEHICLES should be operating inside the Market between 7am and Noon.
- Two week suspensionthis is your first warning.






Where to Go

- Observe the white traffic flow arrows.
- Vendor spaces use the parking space numbers.
- South row spaces are numbered in orange on the curb.
- Rows 2, 3, and 4 have chickens on the median indicating 10ft. Find the space # then line up with the chickens.



Where to Go

- Community Group spaces are indicated in white by a number between two dashes.
- Ignore numbers in red on the curb. They are remanants fro our COVID set up.




 Please set tents up parallel to the curb.

INTERACTIVE MARKET MAP



- Use the interactive map on the Market website:



When to Leave


- Market ends at noon.

- Entrance opening may be held if too many patrons are still in the Market at 12pm – Do Not move barricades.






Where to Go

 Restrooms are located inside the main entrance of the Urbana City Building. Opening time TBD but usually by 7am for sure.




Where to Go

Got a problem?

Come to the Info/City Tent in the north row and get a staff member.

What to bring

- Tent
- Table
- Chairs
- Signage (required). Sandwich board or hanging sign. (11x14 min. Clearly displaying company name, town, state)
- All the stuff you plan to sell and materials needed to set it up.



What to bring

Suggested but not required (not an exhaustive list... but a bit exhausting):

- Lock box for your cash (people still use that stuff)
- Your Square or other card reader
- Sunblock
- Tool kit
- Bungee cords, tie down straps
- Pens
- Spare batteries or a charger for electronics
- Paper towels
- Warm socks
- Wet weather gear
- Gloves
- Comfortable shoes



What to bring

Tent

- Buy a good tent! Eurmax Premium 10x10 =\$289
- Get a fancy color or not it's hard to direct patrons to the "white tent over there" when there's 20 of them in a row... Just something to think about. If you attend other markets of festivals that require a white consider buying a second cover.



What to bring

Tent Weights

- 30 pounds per leg (cinder blocks, kettle bells, 5 gal. buckets of water, custom made, attach securely to legs or tent frame)
- Alternately: secure it to your vehicle (if you have one in the Market) but you might still need weight on some of the legs.
- DO THIS EVERY WEEK, all the times, always, rain or shine...



What to bring

Things to keep you down:

30 pounds per leg. Get creative, the only real criteria is that it's heavy.



















What to bring

Tents aren't the only things that blow over:

Secure your displays against:

- Wind
- Small Children
- Clumsy Adults



What to bring

If it's your first time:

- Do a practice run. Set up in your driveway, make sure everything you need fits in your vehicle, time yourself.
- Drive by the Market site and check things out before your first time.

Market operates Rain or Shine (wind, sleet and snow too) from May through October.

Weather events that will get the Market cancelled or halted:

Lightning

Tornado

Hail

Severe Wind



Emergency! Weather

- In the event of a weather emergency seek shelter inside Lincoln Square Mall or The Urbana City Building.
- This is not to set-up booths to conduct sales. This is only to act as protection from severe weather.
- Do not return to the Market site until directed by Market Staff or public safety officials.

Emergency! Weather

Some weather events may not be severe enough to evacuate or cancel the Market, should you feel your personal safety is in jeopardy you have two options:

- Leave your stall and wait out the weather event in the Urbana City Building, Lincoln Square, or your vehicle until you feel safe returning.
- Pack up your materials and go home.


Please notify Market Staff of your intentions so we can watch your stall or direct your vehicle through the market.

Someone is injured or has fallen:


- Are they responsive?

SNAP/Link

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program formerly known as "food stamps".
- The Market's SNAP program is administered by The Land Connection.
- Program is "locally" universal tokens and coupons can be used at UMATS and Champaign Market.
- Link cardholders will be able to receive a daily double match for every swipe up to \$20 = \$20 in benefits (tokens) plus \$40 in matching incentives (coupons).
- Over \$100,000 in benefits and matching incentives were distributed at UMATS in 2022.

- Vendors selling SNAP-eligible items are required to participate in our SNAP program- growers, bakers, canned goods.
- Weekly remittance of accepted SNAP token and coupons.
- Reimbursement will be made electronically. There will be a fee of \$1 per deposit associated with this service.
